## MASTER BEDROOM Celerie Kemble



**Master bedroom** Celerie Kemble's master bedroom serves as a "sophisticated, year-round retreat from city life." The foliage-inspired wallcovering plays well with the room's fabrics, including the draperies' pinstriped linen and the desk chair's Prussian blue velvet. Sheer draperies on the Henredon upholstered bed enhance the airy atmosphere. Maitland-Smith provided the shell-inlay folding screen, wastebasket, and brass desk lamp. The octagonal sitting room's sofas, armchairs, and petal cocktail table are also by Henredon. Hudson Valley Lighting's aged-brass lantern punctuates the teal ceiling.

**Guest bath** Natural textures and neutral tones underscore this tranquil retreat designed by Alan Court. Recycled leather tiles form a unique wallcovering, which is offset by molding trim painted in Benjamin Moore's "Morning Dew."
