



Master bedroom Celerie Kemble's master bedroom serves as a "sophisticated, year-round retreat from city life." The foliage-inspired wallcovering plays well with the room's fabrics, including the draperies' pinstriped linen and the desk chair's Prussian blue velvet, Sheer draperies on the Henredon upholstered bed enhance the airy atmosphere. Maitland-Smith provided the shell-inlay folding screen, wastebasket, and brass desk lamp.
